Meritorious Contribution	This award is for either groups or individuals who have made significant contributions to research administration through one or more of the following: 1) service to NCURA; 2) publication of articles in the field of research administration; 3) development of an innovative program that enhanced research administration.	Plaque	Nominator should be the Vice Chair/Dean for Research or comparable official from the nominee's institution	Self-nominations are encouraged. Required documents: nomination form, resumé or CV and 2 letters from Region IV members (one of which is external to the institution of the nominee.) Additional letters from faculty are encouraged, but not required.
